	Drones- There are few regulations. User must avoid flying it within 150 metres of a congested area and 50 metres of a person, vessel, vehicle or structure not under the control of the pilot. User will also need to fly the aircraft "within sight". This means you can't go above 400 feet in altitude or further than 500 metres horizontally. PC will monitor the situation to see if this will be a recurrent problem.
