Cllr Warrington confirmed that Chelwood will change to being in a ward with Clutton and Farmborough. This will be a one-member ward. She will check that Chelwood is among the list of proposed polling stations.

The council has been told by Government, along with 27 other authorities, to take urgent action to reduce dangerous nitrogen dioxide levels caused by vehicle emissions in the shortest possible time and by 2021 at the latest. BANES is proposing a Clean Air Directive for Bath city centre. This will affect drivers of petrol vehicles older than 2006 and diesel vehicles older than 2015.
